## **ITEM 1: Approval of the Minutes**

Mr. Giroux made a motion to approve the minutes from March 31, 2016 as amended. Mr. Adamczyk seconded this motion. The minutes passed unanimously.

#### **ITEM 2: Member discussion**

The group discussed the current <u>LIAC SOLICITATION FOR LOCAL INVESTMENT</u> <u>FINANCING PROPOSALS</u> ("open solicitation") and a concept-paper submitted by Champlain Housing Trust for a potential financing proposal. The Committee discussed if the specifications of the concept-paper were in line with the intent of the open solicitation.

Mr. Greenfield made a motion to advise Champlain Housing Trust that the proposed concept-paper did not meet the current "open solicitation" requirements. The Committee noted that the concept submitted by Champlain Housing Trust was clearly a benefit to the

community.
