About Green Mountain Secure Retirement

A 2017 law authorized the creation of the Green Mountain Secure Retirement Plan, a voluntary Multiple Employer Plan (MEP) retirement option for Vermont self-employed individuals and employers of 50 employees or fewer that do not currently offer a retirement plan to their employees.

The law provides that the plan:

- 1) be easy and simple to understand;
- 2) administered to maximize cost effectiveness and efficiency;
- 3) easy to join;
- 4) administered with trustworthy oversight;
- 5) be consumer friendly;
- 6) portable for employees;
- 7) provide choice for individual subscribers;
- 8) voluntary;
- 9) help individuals improve their financial wellness;
- 10) encourage adequate savings for future needs;
- 11) not compete with existing private sector solutions; and
- 12) utilize pretax dollars.
