The Chair, Jon Harris, called the Thursday, March 9, 2023, Board meeting to order at 3:31 p.m. which was held by conference call and in-person at the Treasurer's Conference Room, Pavilion Building, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, 109 State Street, Montpelier, VT.

### **ITEM 1:** Agenda approval and announcements

On a motion made by Ms. Simmons, seconded by Mr. Raddock, the Board voted unanimously to approve the agenda.

**ITEM 2**: Approve the Minutes of:

• February 8, 2023

On a motion made by Ms. Simmons, seconded by Mr. Boyles, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes of February 8, 2023 as presented.

### **ITEM 3:** Legislative Update

Mr. Duggan updated the Board on several key legislative updates as they relate to VSTRS. He indicated that the items in the Budget Adjustment Act continue to not be in dispute; while S.42, an act related to divestment of State pension funds of investments in the fossil fuel industry, has undergone changes since the last meeting to mirror the Middlebury Approach more closely. Mr. Duggan also gave an update on the Marginal Rate Structure in FY 2025 and the retired Teachers'

COLA as conversations between stakeholders remain ongoing.

## **ITEM 4:** Health Insurance Update

Mr. May and Mr. Duggan presented plan experience for VEHI plans in anticipation of the Department of Financial Regulation's annual rate review. Mr. May's analysis yielded low single digit projected increases for the non-Medicare population, while his analysis of the VEHI VSTRS 65 Medicare offering projected an estimated increase of 17%.

Mr. May also shared the preliminary calendar of calculation and review of rates for CY 2024. He noted that the Board will be meeting on May 10<sup>th</sup>, which aligns with necessary timeframe to return a decision to Blue Cross Blue Shield before they file the rates on May 31<sup>st</sup>.

On a motion made by Ms. Mings-Lamar, seconded by Mr. Boyles, the Board voted unanimously to adjourn at 4:21 p.m.
